PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project has cropped out of the unique success foot-prints of the Parent School herein referred to as: ST. THERESA'S NAMAGUNGA P.B.S. The Parents, together with the School management committee agreed to willingly create additional learning centres to harmonize the huge demand for educational programs and/or services, under the establishment of ST. THERESA'S NAMAGUNGA P.B.S.

The Stakeholders then procured a 10 acre Prime land located at Kitende, along Entebbe road, Uganda-Africa.

The construction work is in-progress. By 22nd February 2021, the construction work had covered about 15% of the work schedule. It was visible that limited and/or short supply of material resources had somehow slowed the construction work.

The project will steadily develop various components of school facilities not limited to:

ADMINISTRATION BLOCK, CLASS ROOM BLOCKS, DORMITORY BLOCKS, DINING/
MAIN HALL COMPLEX, CONVENT BLOCK, STAFF QUARTERS AND GAMES /

SPORTS Facilities. The project could cost about UGX 25 billion once fully established.

POWER AND ENERGY

Once established, the educational facility will be highly favored By Mix Diversification of utility subscriptions. The most preferred could be Solar Energy and Electricity from the National Grid However, wood fuel will be used for the preparation of meals. The management shall author a proposal to acquire cleaner and environmentally sustainable Energy for cooking. It is usually expensive to use Electricity or Solar for cooking.

PROJECT OWNERSHIP.

The project will be owned and managed by the LITTLE SISTERS OF ST.FRANCIS with guidance of the Parent School and other relevant stakeholders till it becomes **Self-Reliant.**

PROJECT OPPORTUNITIES.

The Project has already created jobs for over 100 Ugandans. It is yet to create more opportunities for Teachers and other professionals in Africa.

THE CHALLENGE AT HAND:

The Project construction work is at about 15% covered. There is a need to fundraise towards the 85% funds required to complete the construction work and subsequently procure learning material to keep the facility up and running.

WATER & SANITATION:

The National water supply facility is located about 15 minutes drive from the project site.

However, water borne toilet facilities shall be powered using underground pumps not connected to the National Supply facility.

NEIGHBORING COMMUNITY.

The project is blessed to have affluent neighboring communities from Uganda, Africa and beyond.

The neighborhood is highly peaceful, admirable, and conducive for educational services.

OFFLINE VISIBILITY.

The Parent School is Highly Visible at Physical Address and/or Premises. It has enjoyed tremendous media coverage by prominent news papers and some renowned television stations in Africa. The Branch facility is yet to enjoy the same media privilege.

ONLINE VISIBILITY

The Parent School is about 85% visible online through various platforms. It has an active website platform. The school development profile I is up and running on SAFE LIFE prestigious Website platform: www.safelifeuganda.org.
