By Safe Life Team In Uganda

The re-known Ugandan Anti HIV/AIDS activist / good health campaigner cum author of the Anti HIV/AIDS Anthem, Patrick Donald Oucha, has called upon sections of health related foreign NGOs to actively support Ugandan innovations instead of exploiting young talents in the name of voluntarism.

Briefing a team of Safe Life researchers at his Upper Naguru office, August 10th, Oucha disclosed that most foreign NGOs have 'blind eyes' that do not identify the right innovations for the communities and some of those who have eyes to see are also in most cases biased.

"We must understand that a Ugandan mind understands best the geography and circumstances surrounding people and it is the same mind that can be very innovative in coming up with initiatives that have solutions to community questions / issues. So it is this same mind that should be supported by the foreign actors who are instead broadly blessed with financial resources" Oucha explains

Adding that

"Most of these foreign NGOs you see are using local innovations without promoting the initiators of such innovations in the process frustrating Ugandan productive minds, a situation that has future negative impact on individual creativity and community development in general."

Putting slightly an unusual face, Oucha stunned a very attentive team when he

disclosed that one of the foreign NGOs was involved in illegally hawking his gazetted HIV/AIDS Anthem across Africa, a move that was calmed by the interventions of Ugandan legal experts.

"Some of the NGOs are very funny and good at lifting innovations from Uganda with intention of transplanting the same for their own selfish gains" Oucha observes. On voluntarism, our poet analytically briefed the team that some Ugandan talented young people volunteer to go on televisions in the name of disseminating information for organisations and get no reward at all; a situation that has since ceased being practical in Europe and some other continents around the globe.

"If some foreign NGO workers in Uganda reside in accommodation or houses of not less than \$3000 per month and are paid huge allowances for simple work performed, why should our people volunteer to only be given a bottle of mineral water or lunch which is less than a dollar? They must be paid the little they deserve." Oucha explains.

Moving towards the end of this interaction, Oucha warns that be it NGO or not, business is the underlying factor and parties involved must not lose one to another in whatever form. He advised NGOs to include the so called volunteers on their pay roll especially those on pensions.

Earlier in the month, Oucha sensitised thousands of West Nile students on the dangers of HIV/AIDS and how to keep Safe for a Life time. He enjoys support and good relations with the Government that stretch over decades. His core campaigns against HIV/AIDS were preliminarily supported by over 3000 schools and school head teachers in Uganda creating a big following for his Anti-AIDS programmes in Uganda and beyond.



London based Ugandan visiting media academic / journalist, Mr Kennedy Javuru, August 10th commended Patrick Donald Oucha of Safe Life Uganda for the work well performed in the authorship and dissemination of the HIV/AIDS Anthem across Uganda and beyond.

"ANGAL HOSPITAL BOSS RAPES SICKLE CELL PATIENTS

young lady in Nebbi District Ms Ochida Irene is officially alleging that she was on the 15th day of November, 2009 at 18:00 hrs raped at Angal Hospital, Nebbi by the Laboratory Manager one Chekerom Lawrence, a situation that has resulted into unplanned birth of a healthy child, Giramia Jovia.

"I am a sickle cell patient receiving routine treatment at Angal Referral hospital in Padyere County, Nebbi District. It was on the 15th day of November, 2009 that Lawrence Chekerom raped me within a three (3) room laboratory. I made an alarm but he squeezed my mouth and I could not shout any further. He made love to me forcefully and here is the child" says Ochida with tears rolling down her face.

Adding that

"Apart from denying the rape case, Lawrence has neglected the child and swore never to give a helping hand." $[T] = \frac{1}{2} \int_{-\infty}^{\infty} \frac{1}{2} \int_$

A source, however, speaking on condition of anonymity quotes Lawrence as having said thus:

"This young lady (Ochida) approached me to help terminate pregnancy but I told her it could worsen her bad health. So I convinced her not to terminate. In the process, I promised to look after the child but after safe delivery, the lady became stubborn, involved parties who were not privy to this affair. I made up my mind and advised her to run to FIDA wherever they operate so that my name can be cleared from this mess."

Meanwhile, according to our legal department, a rape case will not stand against Lawrence since Ochida herself did not report the matter immediately after it had occurred.

Some members of the community who approached Safe Life Uganda, on condition of anonymity, called on Government and Angal hospital administration to clean up the mess which is believed to have been running for such a long time but lacked media exposure.

Angal hospital is one of the oldest in Uganda serving nearly three (3) countries. It is the first time this rot within the hospital is reaching the media.

Efforts to reach the Hospital MS and the Hospital Administrator for comments were unsuccessful as all their phones called without response. A source in Nebbi town council says "The matter shall be heard in court as a case of child neglect but not rane"

Meanwhile, due to loss of blood at birth, Ochida's sickle cell status has worsened. Both the mother and child require sustainable assistance from concerned Organisations.
