He has been around the block campaigning against HIV/Aids for over a decade.

He has been to over 2,500 schools around the Country and been acclaimed by district, health and education authorities. His name has become a household name in Uganda. He is a man people living with HIV/AIDS find pleasure meeting because he inspires them into great hope.

But who is this enigmatic poet and composer whose four-stanza Anti-Aids Anthem got gazetted on March 18th, 2005?

After two years trying to get an interview with him, Patrick Donald Oucha finally agreed but on condition that the interview would be published only in Safe Life Uganda newsletter.

And this was a privilege indeed because Oucha has turned down tens of requests for interview by the local press and broadcast media.

Oucha was orphaned at the tender age of two, reason why he vows he will live to uplift orphans and other disadvantaged children in the Country.

Oucha is a highly disciplined man, the reason he has managed all odds to succeed. He says, although many women express admiration for him, he hardly responds.

On the composition of the gazetted Anthem, Oucha says;

"It took me 70 days of silence and meditation in the idyllic Baha'i Temple gardens in Uganda and heavy prayers every morning to be able to perfect the Anthem, adding that;

"The world is a very noisy place; there is also noise inside the body. The only way you can achieve something tangible is by silencing both the outer and the inner noise".

He says, he has neither love for politics nor hatred for politicians; and admires President Yoweri Kaguta Museveni without hiding it.

But as most people of genius, Oucha is a man of many talents and faces; a sort of jerk of all trades.

He has entrusted Seven _Eleven Property Company Limited with the distribution of the copyrighted Anthem. The Company distributes it through the newsletter *Safe Life Uganda*. The newsletter simply sells advertising space and with two issues so far, Organisations and Companies are rushing to buy space. Over 8,000 copies have been distributed in Kampala alone. The target is to reach every Ugandan home before embarking on exportation of the Anthem.
