AN EYE ON THE SOLDIER PROFESSOR WAMBA DIA WAMBA

We have learnt with shock the untimely demise of Africa's multitask personality Late professor Ernest Wamba Dia wamba, formally the President of the Rally for Congolese Democracy (RCD) Kisangani faction. Patrick Donald Oucha (prophet) interfaced with the professor in his Bunia High command office, Ituri province in early March 2000. The Professor loved his Revolver Shotgun and army green outfit. His high command Office in Bunia town was open 24/7 to visitors regardless of origin and colour. He was a pride-free elderly African who would allot quality time in response to every meaningful request. He had zero discrimination on the one part and unique inbuilt drive to serve the people of the DRC with Humility, Love, Honesty and Diligence. However, like a successful human person, the professor had both Strengths and Weaknesses.

FEARS AND TEARS

While in the Ituri war sector, the president of the RCD-Kisangani faction, Professor Wamba Dia Wamba registered drop of tears on many occasions, the professor wept at Bunia Airport, aboard the TMK Aircraft scheduled for Entebbe APRIL 2000. He was very nervous and suspicious that his colleagues reportedly planted a bomb to finish him while in mid Air. "Fellow colleagues I decline to travel aboard this flight. Why do people want to finish me? what have I done to empower them take off my life? Ok we shall see!" Wamba expressed himself minute after minute as he finally chose to travel aboard a different Aircraft with verified security safety.

About 6 officials of the RCD failed their concerted effort to make Wamba change his mind and withdraw his baseless suspicion. "I have made up my mind, I shall not use this private transport, let Uganda send for me an official transport to Air lift me to Uganda." suggested the visibly fearful Rebel boss. However Wamba disembarked off the parked Aircraft and he was immediately driven to his posh offices in Bunia awaiting an official air transport from Uganda.

It was at about 6pm Congo time that Kampala reportedly scheduled a Military rescue chopper (Sura Mbaya) which lifted Wamba Dia Wamba the same evening "In Kampala, some officials of Uganda government reportedly put the officials of RCD Kisangani for a brief lecture on how to deal with emotional issues in the War sector," said a source close to Wamba. It was after the Kampala meeting that Wamba regained interest and got back to his Rebel activity in Bunia. His chief spokes person, the Late Ujanga said "professor was convinced that his safety and life was in good hands. So no need to fear."

However, following the inter-congolese dialogue that ended the War, Wamba became a prominent member of the new government of Joseph Kabila. Some of Wamba's colleagues became ministers. Wamba remained a key figure in the authorship of what the RCD needed for successful transition to a functioning Democracy.
